I am a local in awe of the community spirit and culture of the Centres Board and staff members. Should my nomination be successful, my management, writing and educator qualifications will be useful where needed.



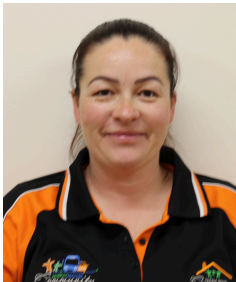
Ben Jackson
